Welcome

We are so excited to have you as a part of our new growing dance family! We are so excited for our second year as a studio. Our staff is crazy talented and absolutely fantastic. We have been working hard to prepare awesome classes and can not wait to get to know each of you and your dancers.

Registration

Registration is due when registering. It holds your spot in your class. Registration fee is due once per dance season (September - June). It is \$25 per dancer with a maximum registration fee of \$65 per family.

Tuition

Tuition is due the first day of every month starting September 1st. If you need to change that to the 15th please contact me via email. **Statements will be sent out a couple days before fees are due.** All balances must be cleared by the 15th or a late fee will be added to all delinquent accounts. Late fees are \$10 a week until your balance is cleared.

Costume Fees

Our Costume Fee is \$75 per costume (with the one exception being Boy's Club). This fee will include the costume, any tights or embellishments, and any

alterations that may be needed. We pride ourselves on well fitting amazing costumes. This fee can be paid all at once or is split into three equal monthly installments. We will split your costume fees into those monthly installments automatically unless asked to do otherwise. You will be charged for Costumes on October 1st, November 1st and December 1st. *This doesn't apply to non recital classes

Recital Fee

Each dancer will have a \$25 recital fee. This is not due until May 1st. It pays for each dancer's closing number t-shirt as well as glow sticks that they will be using in the closing number. *This doesn't apply to non recital classes

Shoes and Dress Code

The first week of class we will have an in studio shoe fitting and you can purchase all shoes through the studio. However, if you choose to purchase somewhere else or already have the correct shoes no problem! We will also have dancewear available for purchase. Please make sure that your dancer has their hair up and wears something stretchy and form fitting the first week of class. If they are in a power tap or hip-hop class they should wear tennis shoes. If they are in ballet leotards, pink tights, and buns are required. We have a no midriff policy at our studio.
